OR, FIND OUT EXACTLY
WHAT YOU'RE ENTITLED TO
UNDER THE NEW AGREEMENT

Effective from the date of this Agreement, medical staff will be entitled to nine weeks' salary upon commencement of maternity/adoption leave. Effective from 1 October 2009, medical staff will be entitled to payment of nine weeks' salary upon commencement of maternity/adoption leave and costs reimbursement. Where medical staff are required by the hospital to work outside of their ordinary rostered hours of work and where they have given their notice of the requirement to perform such overtime with approval by the hospital, other than recall when placed on call, the doctor will be reimbursed for reasonable childcare expenses incurred. Recognition of interstate Long Service Leave Accrual Prospectively: Doctors that commenced employment with a Victorian public health service after 30 November 2008 will have service with an interstate government health service recognised for the purpose of calculating Long Service Leave entitlements. Service in an interstate government health service where such service commenced within 2 months of commencing employment with a Victorian Public Health Service will be counted for the purpose of calculating Long Service Leave entitlements. Review of Private Practice arrangements in public hospitals: The parties agreed to enter into discussions regarding Review of Private Practice arrangements throughout the life of the Agreement. Retirement entitlements: All entitlements received by a doctor prior to the commencement of this Agreement are over and above the provisions of this Agreement will continue to apply. All amendments to the current arrangement will be implemented at the earliest date possible and subsequently by agreement.
